| ADVANTAGES

- Durability – Very hard-wearing, scratch-resistant, and resistant to impact.
- Moisture resistant – Won't swell, warp, or rot if exposed to water (good near pools or outdoors).
- Low maintenance – Easy to clean, doesn't need sealing, oiling, or repainting.
- Hygienic – Non-porous surface resists bacteria and staining.
- Colour choice – Available in many colours/finishes, consistent look. (Cubicle partitions, vanities, lockers, wall linings can all be finished in the same colour/material for consistent look)
- UV stable (with right grade) – Some versions resist fading outdoors.
- Repairability – Smaller chips/scratches can be repaired with colour matched wax




| CHALLENGES

- Comfort – Harder, colder surface compared to timber.
- Appearance – Modern, manufactured look – lacks natural grain/character.
- Weight – Can be very heavy to install
- Cost – material is more expensive than pine, however being a prefinished material results in less factory/installation labour is required (so the overall cost is cost neutral compared with Pine Timber)








| ADVANTAGES

- Natural aesthetic – Warm, classic look with natural grain.
- Comfort – Warmer to touch, more “forgiving” to sit on than laminate.
- Lightweight – Easier to handle and install.
- Affordable – Lower material cost than laminate.
- Customisable – Can be painted, stained, or shaped easily.
- Repairable – Can be sanded, refinished, or patched if damaged

| CHALLENGES

- Maintenance – Requires regular sealing, staining, or painting to protect.
- Durability – Softer wood, dents and scratches more easily.
- Moisture issues – Even treated pine can warp, split, or rot over time outdoors.
- UV exposure – Fades, cracks, or weathers if unprotected.
- Shorter lifespan – Won't last as long as compact laminate in high-traffic or wet areas.
- Cost – As this is an unfinished material, pine timber requires additional factory/installation labour to bring to a finished product (so the overall cost is cost neutral compared with Compact Laminate)


Finish (Standard):
