Full height, floor to ceiling 13mm compact laminate panels with black core of thermosetting resins to IS EN 438-4 available in **DuraLam™** antibacterial colour range. Certified antimicrobial to JIS Z 2801 to prevent the growth of bacteria on the surface up to 99% within 24 hours.

2.2 CHANNELS, RAILS AND BRACKETS

Extruded aluminium alloy 6060 with exposed face anodic coated.

Head rail: 60mm x 33mm

Wall channel: 13mm x 30mm

2.3 DOORS

To match rigid panels with routed, curved, polished edges and predrilled for hardware

Components - DuraPlan® Altitude Range toilet, shower & changing partition system**2.4 HINGES**

Three self-closing stainless steel hinges per door with bolt through security fixings, to match the aluminium section in size.

2.5 PEDESTALS

Altitude Range system is supported by full height centre pilaster

2.6 INDICATOR BOLT AND KEEPER

DuraPlan® standard stainless steel indicator turn-bolt and keeper, brushed finish.

2.7 HAT AND COAT HOOKS

DuraPlan® standard stainless steel coat hook integrated door stop

3 EXECUTION**Conditions**

3.1 DELIVERY, STORAGE AND HANDLING

Take delivery of **DuraPlan®** panels and accessories and store horizontally on site and protect from damage. Protect finished surfaces, edges and corners. Move/handle goods in accordance with **DuraPlan®** requirements. Reject and replace goods that are damaged or will not provide the required finish. Panels must be pre-conditioned to the room in which they are to be installed for not less than 24 hours prior to fixing.

3.2 PRE-INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

Check work previously carried out and confirm it is of the required standard for this part of the work. Ensure substrate plumb, level and in true alignment.

3.3 INSTALL SCREENS

Carry out the fixing, erection and fitting to finish rigid, plumb, true to line and face and square, to **DuraPlan®** requirements.

3.4 INSTALL COMPONENTS

Hang doors and fit hardware to the **DuraPlan®** requirements.

Completion

3.5 ROUTINE CLEANING

Carry out routine trade cleaning of this part of the work including periodic removal of all packaging, debris, unused and temporary materials and components from the site.

3.6 DEFECTIVE OR DAMAGED WORK

Repair damaged or marked elements. Replace damaged or marked elements where repair is not possible or will not be acceptable. Leave work to the standard required by **DuraPlan®**.

3.7 REPLACE

Replace any damaged or marked elements.

3.8 LEAVE

Leave work with parts fully and freely working and to the standard required by **DuraPlan®**.

3.9 PROTECTION

When working with **DuraPlan®** panels, do not remove protective film until installation is complete and the work area is clean.
